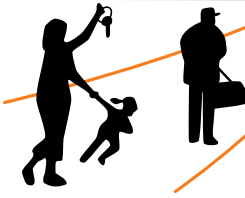

WHAT : The Bring LA Home Blue Ribbon Panel is holding 6 community meetings throughout the County to present the 10-year plan framework to end homelessness with interested persons and solicit comments and suggestions on the plan's recommendations.

WHO : Bring LA Home! is a panel of over 60 representatives of local government, law enforcement, faith-based organizations, business, labor, service providers, advocates, formerly homeless and academics.

WHY : There are more than 78,600 homeless people in Los Angeles County every night. Some 254,000 are homeless over the course of a year. The mission of Bring LA Home is "To prevent and end homelessness in Los Angeles County by creating and implementing a comprehensive, innovative, and realistic ten-year strategic plan."
